- **Mediator (bringing resources together to make it happen).**



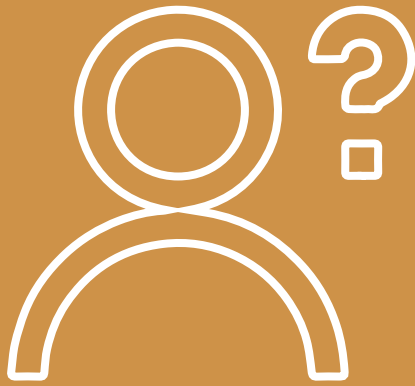

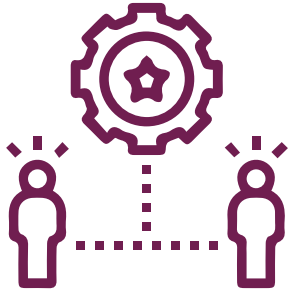
Program Outlay
